A Streamlined, Student-Centered Learning Experience

The courses on HTHU are provided in a variety of formats to support different learning styles- audio, self-paced reading, video, and downloadable note sheets to use along the way. Administrators can also incorporate written assignments to submit as a part of coursework and other interactive tools. In addition, coursework is accessible on a variety of devices and across multiple platforms and browsers, including PCs, tablets, and iPads. From your organization's custom dashboard, Students log in and can enroll in courses, complete coursework, take exams, view and print transcripts, and view completed and upcoming courses assigned by administrators. Administrators have management and reporting capabilities, and can assign courses to students through the system if preferred.

Program and Pricing Options

There are a number of program structures available, and pricing of programs is based on number of students and courses selected to offer on an annual basis.
