In order to build your personal portfolio over time, it is important that you use your unique user login each time you access the HTHU system. Your simple instructions for creating a user account are provided below.

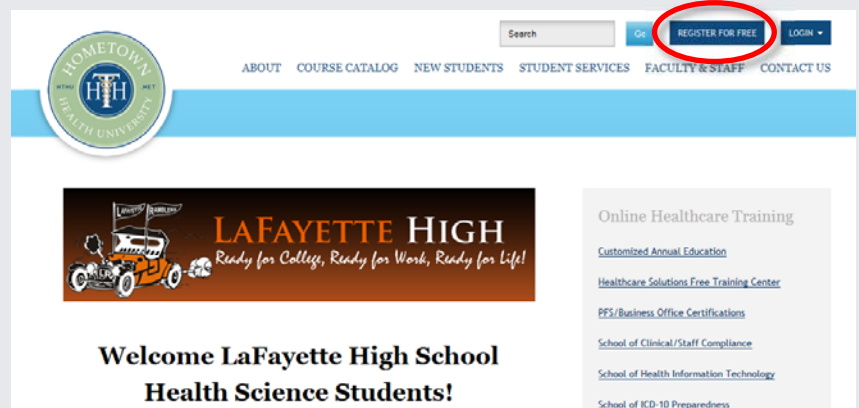
### To Create a New Student Account: *First Time Only*

1. Go to [www.hthu.net/lafayette](http://www.hthu.net/lafayette)
2. Click the blue “Register For Free” Button.
3. Create a User Account by following the prompts.

a. **For your username: Please use the last two digits of your graduation year + first initial first name + last name. For example: If Jennifer Smith is a part of the class of 2016, her user name would be “16jsmith.”**

b. Make sure to select “**LaFayette High School**” from the facility/organization field dropdown box.

4. Before you access a course, you will be prompted to complete a brief “User Orientation” to teach you to navigate through the system. Although you can opt to close out of the course once you begin, it is recommended that you take this course in its completion to answer many frequently asked questions.



### Beginning Coursework

To begin a course, login in to your student dashboard on [www.hthu.net/LaFayette](http://www.hthu.net/LaFayette) and select the course link that is assigned to you by your instructor. Review the course information, and click on the “enroll” button to begin a course. You also can download or print a copy of the notes in each course’s “Digital Library.”
