Tips for Using HTHU.net Courses in Your Healthcare Science Program

We are pleased to offer your students access to online education courses through HTHU.net. This education is used by healthcare employees in hospitals and physician offices across the nation– and we hope that it serves to help your students to build a solid foundation as a successful future healthcare professional. The courses offered to your students can be used in the manner of your choosing - some ideas are included below!

- Have your students print the completion certificates at the end of each course. As they continue to use HTHU through their four year pathway, these certificates can be included in their senior portfolio so potential employers or colleges will observe the success of their commitment to education throughout their high school years.
- Assign each course to your students to complete, perhaps integrating it into your curriculum where it best fits, and then discuss what they learned from the course together as a class. Ask them to share how the learning outcomes would help them in their future employment, and to share what they learned that they didn't know before.
- Use the courses as extra credit, Senior Projects, or other Independent Research Projects--- allow your students to select a course of their choice, and to submit a synopsis/critique or additional reflection on the topic.
- Use the courses to allow your students to explore areas outside of their selected Pathway -- it may spark an interest in a new area of healthcare!
- Students looking for work-based learning or internships with local providers? Encourage your students to share what they have completed, and what they learned from the experience on hthuh.net to set them apart from others. Set up mock interviews and allow them to practice discussing the course topics they have completed.
- Assign HTHU.net courses to students to complete during inclement weather days or during the summer! As long as the student can access the internet, they can access their online courses.
