

# Roadmap to HSE IC Success...

- 1. Go to https://hthu.net/gateacher21
- 2. Review Program Operational Standards (POS) I-VI
- 3. Review Course Standards that you teach; select 3 standards per course you teach to showcase.
- 4. Begin setting up your website.
  - Create buttons for pages to house each component of HSE IC.
- 5. Create a digital folder (Google, Microsoft, etc.) to set up for filing your HSE IC documents and label it HSE IC.
  - Create sub folders for the following:
    - Program of Operational Standards
    - A separate folder for each course taught with chosen standards (lesson plans, completed student activities, completed student assessments/evaluations per each element)
    - Follow the organizational order of each component found on evaluation rubrics.


