Congratulations for meeting the criteria to pursue Industry Certification! Although you will teach all courses and standards for your pathway as usual, your program will be evaluated as outlined below.

- 1. Select three <u>standards</u> from <u>each</u> course taught:
 - Consider standards that are most critical for mastery of course content and career/postsecondary success.
 - Showcase artifacts for each of these standards and elements (substandards) artifacts should be no more than 2 years old
- 2. Required documentation:
 - Lesson plan for each standard and element
 - Student work evidence of teaching/learning assignments, projects, etc show examples from the past two years
 - Evaluation of student work assessments, rubrics examples from the past two years
 - Upload documents and artifacts to your website protect student privacy
 - Pictures may be used as supporting evidence but do not take the place of rubrics and assessments
- 3. Industry Certification Final Evaluation (onsite or virtual)
 - Coordinate date with HSE IC Coordinator and Hometown Health University
 - Select and secure at least six local health care professionals to serve as evaluation team members
 - Select a total of three to ten students for interviews
 - Arrange for interviews with guidance counselor and administrator(s) Principal or designee and CTAE Director
 - Using the POS checklists, evaluation team will determine if teacher(s) and program meet the exemplary status of Industry Certified Program for Healthcare Science. HSE IC Coordinator will prepare final report.
- Industry Certified programs and teachers will be recognized at the annual Summer GACTE-GADOE-CTAE Conference during the Healthcare Science Technology Educators Association (HSTEA) Awards Program in June.
